

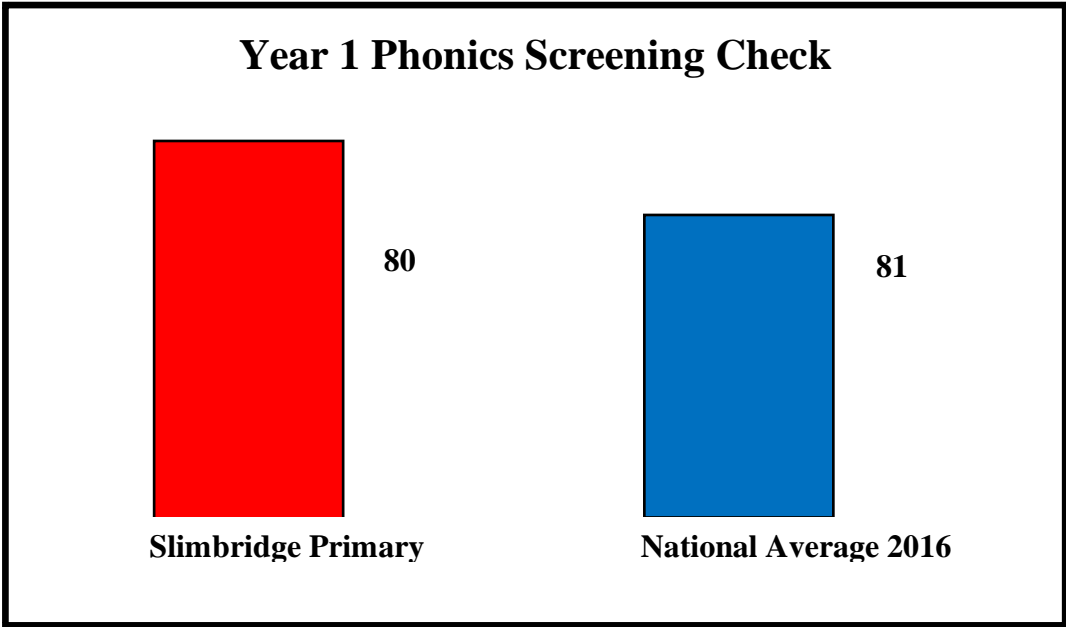
**2017 Attainment**

The children at Slimbridge Primary School are tested to allow direct comparisons between other children nationally in Year 1, 2 and 6.

Children in Reception are assessed against the Early Years Foundation Stage to achieve a “good level of development” a child needs to be at “expected” in communication and language, literacy and maths, personal social and emotional and physical development.

At the end of Year 1 children are tested on their Phonetic knowledge using both regular and nonsense words. This year we equalled the national level.

## KS1 Attainment

At KS1 (Year 2) all assessments are based on Teacher Assessment, although Slimbridge School does use Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs) in reading, grammar, punctuation, spelling and maths to support teacher assessments.

## KS2 Attainment

Most pupils are expected to achieve a standardised score of 100 or above by the end of key stage 2, this is an “expected achievement”. Assessments are based on standard assessment tests, except for writing which is teacher assessed.
