16th January 2026 – Young Voices – BP Pulse Live Birmingham for Year 5 and 6

Exciting times, the Young Voices journey is nearly here! We are so excited about joining in this amazing occasion.

We have some updates for parents now the day is fast approaching.

You have now received your ticket(s) via email and children have been given their t-shirts and torches in school today. Please check your children's bags for these items when they come home. Children who were not in school today have had their t-shirts put in their school trays for safe keeping.

T-shirts

T-shirts that have been ordered online have been handed out to children today and will need to be worn next Friday. Please do not worry if your child does not have one, a plain white T-shirt for the concert will suffice.

Plan for the day: Friday 16th January 2026

Your child will need:

- Waterproof coat
- Packed lunch and tea (enough food for two meals)
- Water bottle and plenty of fluids to last the day (no fizzy or energy drinks)
- Please be aware that your child will be responsible for their own belongings, so please do not pack valuables in their small rucksack
- No need to bring a book bag on the day
- No mobile phones or electronic devices – these are not permitted

Timings for the day:

Children will travel to Birmingham by coach, **departing school at 10:30 a.m.**

Coach costs are £28.00 per child, the school is subsidising this and the children's entrance to the arena is also paid for by the school as part of our music curriculum. So, we would kindly ask for a contribution of **£20** towards the coach cost. A payment has been set up on ParentPay for parents to support this valuable trip. Thank you in advance for your contributions, this is greatly appreciated, as it is only with parents' contributions that an experience like this is possible.



We will spend the afternoon at the Birmingham arena rehearsing, before holding a concert for parents in the evening. Venue doors open for parents at **5p.m.** The concert starts at **7p.m.** and finishes at **8:45p.m.** Please ensure your mobile tickets are ready to be displayed on your phone screen upon arrival, and make sure your phone is charged to avoid any issues at the door.

Young Voices highly recommend that all children are taken back to school on the coach as this is the safest option and avoids long waits at the end of the concert. Therefore, **ALL children are to be collected from Slimbridge School site after the concert.** We will leave the arena at 9 p.m. and expect to return to school at approximately 10:30 p.m.

Programmes are available to purchase on the night. There will also be food and beverage outlets but a reminder that the venue operates a cashless system. The venue encourages customers to avoid bringing a bag where possible as these will be subject to security checks.
